About this policy

This Policy explains what cookies are and how we use them. It includes details of the types of Cookies we set, the information we collect when using them and how that information is used.

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files which are stored on your browser when you visit a website. They can often serve crucial functions and help us to keep our website secure and to function properly which helps us to provide you with a better experience. They can also help us to analyse how the website performs, what works and where we can make improvements.

How We Use Cookies

We use both Strictly Necessary and Analytics cookies. These are used to understand how the website performs, how you interact with it, and helps us to provide you with a better, faster and improved experience.

Social Media and External Links – where you access us via external links or social media platforms, or when you click on external links from our site, we have no control over those websites and the cookies they set, so please bear in mind that you should set your preferences in line with their own policies and cookie controls separately.

How to Manage Cookies – When you visit our site you will be asked if you want to accept cookies. You can reject all non necessary cookies or simply continue to use the site without accepting these and any non-necessary cookies will not load onto your browser.

No matter what cookie control is in place, or if you simply change your mind you can revisit by clicking on the cookie icon and change your preferences. You may need to clear your browser to remove any historical cookies though. At any time you can also adjust your own browser to delete or block cookies from any site you visit. What Cookies Do We Set?

Necessary Cookies

We use necessary functional cookies which are needed for security and for the website to function. They do not collect your personal data. These are automatically enabled when you visit the site, however you can still remove these cookies via your browser, however disabling these will affect the functionality of the site.

Analytics Cookies

We use Analytics cookies to help us to understand how the number of visitors to our website and how they interact with it, for example which pages are visited and for how long. These help us to continually improve our website and services. The data is reported anonymously without any personal data included.

_ga	This cookie is used by Google analytics to calculate visitor, session and campaign data and keep track of site usage for our analytics report.	Persistent	First	2 Years
_gid	This cookie is used by Google Analytics to store information on how visitors use our website, whilst creating analytics data of the sites performance. It anonymously logs the number of visitors, the source and the pages visited.	Persistent	First	1 Day
_gat_gtag_UA	This cookie is set by Google Analytics to distinguish users.	Persistent	First	30 minutes
_ga_ZG3QJ8CTF6	This cookie is set by Google Analytics to distinguish Users	Persistent	First	30 minutes
